Dear Mayor Brooks and Members of the Board:

This letter acknowledges receipt of a certified copy of the fiscal year 2022 budget.

We have reviewed the budget and have determined that projected revenues and other available funds are sufficient to meet anticipated expenditures. Our review of the budget is based solely on the information we have received. With regard to programs included in the budget such as education, roads, and corrections, we have not attempted to determine that the local government has complied with specific program statutes or guidelines, or with any financing requirements prescribed by any state or federal agency. Please note local officials are required to ensure the budget remains balanced throughout the fiscal year and that all maintenance of effort requirements are met — our office has not reviewed or approved any maintenance of effort programs in this budget. Budget amendments must be sent to our office for formal acknowledgement after they are approved by the local governing body (submit to: LGF@cot.tn.gov).

This letter constitutes approval, by this office, for the County's fiscal year 2022 budget as adopted by the County Commission. However, we would like to bring the following considerations to your attention.

Considerations Regarding the Budget

Budget Adoption

The County's budget was adopted on July 19, 2021, and filed with our office on July 29, 2021. Please ensure next year's budget is adopted prior to the beginning of the fiscal year and filed with our office within 15 days of its adoption. Please be aware that budgets that are not filed with our office within two months of the beginning of the fiscal year will not be approved by our office. Pursuant to state law the County may not issue debt or financing obligations without an approved budget from our office.

Significant Budgeted Decreases in Cash

Three of the County's funds are budgeted to spend significantly into their cash reserves to balance their budgets for fiscal year 2022: the General Fund, Solid Waste Fund and the General Purpose School Fund. To ensure the County's operations are not affected negatively by declining cash balances in those funds, the County should closely monitor budget performance throughout the year and look for ways to increase revenues or decrease expenditures in the near future. We recommend a copy of the "Seven Keys to Fiscally Well-Managed Government" be downloaded from our website (tncot.cc/7keys) and shared with the County's governing body for review prior to the development of its budget for fiscal year 2023.
