In August 2024, I worked 13 of 13 scheduled days. I had 64 veterans (and/or family members) in the office. Thirty-five of these veterans had claims that I submitted and was approved or helped them to get a service connection increase in their disability. I also offered the veterans information on the additional benefits that may have become available because of their age or benefits that may be available to them as their service-connected disability increased. Many times, their healthcare and pharmacy benefits are put in a higher priority group. There are eight levels of VA Healthcare for veterans. This involves different Co-payments and costs for medications. When a veteran becomes 50% disabled, they go in a different priority group and his or her medications that are prescribed by the VA are totally covered.

I responded and helped with another 40 veteran telephone call requests mail and/or email/fax correspondence. Veterans' issues are varied and require knowledge in navigating the system to receive each service. Learning to navigate the VA system is ever changing and requires constant research and development.

In August I had training with Special Claims which may include but not limited to 1. Auto Allowance (fitting an automobile so the veteran can drive). 2. Adaptive Housing (making the home safe for the veteran) 3. HISA (grants for home improvement (such as bathroom for wheelchair) 4. Loss of limbs, eyesight or ALS.

On August 14 had zoom training on challenges of going back to civilian life Suicide Prevention of Veterans. 1. Transition and Separation from service 2. Common mental health problems 3. Barriers to treatment for the veteran 4. Building trust w/veteran
