SUBJECT: Significant Actions Report—January 2025

In January 2025, I worked 13 of 13 scheduled days. I had 53 veterans (and/or family members) in the office. Many of these veterans had claims that had been submitted and were approved, or I helped them to get a Service, Connection increase in their disability. I also offered the veterans information on the additional benefits that may have become available to them because of their age or benefits that may be available to them as their Service-Connected disability increased. Sometimes, the veterans' healthcare and pharmacy benefits are changed, and they are put in a higher priority group as their disability changes or stated condition becomes worse.

I responded and helped with another 26 veteran request with telephone calls or emails, including fax correspondence with information/planning etc. This office served a total of 43 veterans and families with service-connected disabilities ranging from 10%- 100% along with healthcare and pension. Issues with these veterans are varied and sometimes complex. It is my understanding that VA healthcare ID cards can now be made at any out-patient clinic where the veteran's primary care doctor is located including Morristown, Knoxville, and Lafollette

On January 22 I received required Quarterly Training with several subject matters including the "VA Duty to Assist Law" which has several stipulations and is very time sensitive that many veterans are not aware of. Other topics covered were Secondary conditions of a Service-Connected disability, Causation / or Aggravation of a disability and Inadequate Medical Evaluations of stated conditions on the application of the veteran.
