March 3rd, 2025 – Cleaned Courthouse and Mayor’s Office, vacuumed County Clerk’s Office, sprayed doorknobs, handrails and benches with disinfectant spray, got trash at the Courthouse, took trash to the convenience center, tore out a handwashing sink at the Library, took a load of materials to the Landfill, took a box of books from Register of Deeds Office to 3rd floor.

March 4th, 2025 – Cleaned Courthouse and Mayor’s Office, mopped restrooms and Mayor’s Office, sprayed doorknobs, handrails and benches with disinfectant spray, stocked supply closet, got trash at the Courthouse, 4-H Office and Finance Office, took a case of toilet paper to 4-H Office.

SUBJECT: Significant Actions Report—March 2025

In March 2025, I worked 12 of 12 scheduled days. I had 47 veterans (and/or family members) in the office. Many of these veterans had claims that had been submitted and were approved. Some of these veterans were assisted in getting a Service Connection increase in their disability. I also offered the veterans information on the additional benefits that may have become available to them because of their age or benefits that may be available to them as their Service-Connected disability increased. Sometimes, the veterans' healthcare and pharmacy benefits are changed, and they are put in a higher priority group as their disability changes or stated condition becomes worse with age and declining health. Some veterans were in to file a completely new claim for disabilities of VA healthcare. I received several reports from veterans that their claim was approved, and this makes my position very rewarding

I responded and helped with another 34-veteran request with telephone calls or emails, including fax correspondence with information/planning etc. This office served a total of 39 veterans (and families) with service-connected disabilities ranging from 10%- 100% along with healthcare and pension claims. Issues with these veterans are varied and sometimes complex. It is my understanding that VA healthcare ID cards can now be made at any out-patient clinic where the veteran's primary care doctor is located including Morristown, Knoxville, and LaFollette TN.

There is legislation that will be presented sometime this year (2025) that will include dental service for veterans. If approved, it will be phased in to allow the VA time to hire new dentists and employees into the system. This would be a great benefit for veterans if this bill passes. Currently only veterans who are 100% service connected and veterans who sustained injuries are covered with dental service.

The Tennessee Department of Veterans Service will be implementing a new Claims Management System in May 2025. Its implementation will offer improvements to claim management and there is no cost to the county as all cost of the program and training will be provided by TDVS.

The local Veterans of Foreign Wars has requested to take part in the county's annual Memorial Day and Veterans Day program at the Tazewell Memorial Park across from the post office. They want to become more visible, and service oriented in the community.
