BUDGET AMENDMENT – FUND 176

**WHEREAS**, at the beginning of the fiscal year (July 1, 2025) there was \$200,000 in the line item 176-91200-404 (Asphalt). These funds are generated through wheel tax.

**WHEREAS**, paving has taken place (Goins Chapel Road-2.3 miles) during August 2025, spending \$174,225.10 of this line item 176-91200-404 (Asphalt). There is \$25,774.90 remaining in this line item.

**WHEREAS**, due to the price of asphalt, it would be beneficial to move the remaining funds of \$25,774.90 to the following line item so that the remaining funds could be used for oil that is used for tar and chip.
